

## **NOTICE TO SAILORS**

## CCSC Ladies Sailing – Change to Sailing Programme 2020

- 1. Ladies Sailing Sessions before 6<sup>th</sup> July have been cancelled due to Government restrictions put in place to prevent the spread of Covid-19 virus.
- 2. From 6<sup>th</sup> July the programme for Ladies Sailing will be as follows:

Every Friday from 10<sup>th</sup> July to the end of September safety cover will be provided on the water from 10am – 12 midday, providing conditions are deemed suitable by the safety team.

Club members must not gather in groups of more than 6 onshore and social distancing rules of 2m (or 1m+ if mitigations are in place) must be observed at all times.

- 3. Ladies Sailing sessions is an opportunity for club members to enjoy time on the water with supervision and safety cover. It is open to all competent adult sailors.
- 4. Notes:

Note 1 – A course will be set by the safety team. This will be displayed on a white board at the bottom of the steps as a briefing will not be possible.

Note 2 - Boats should stay close to the course unless they do not require safety cover.

Notes 3 – Safety boats will be manned by either 1 crew or 2 crew from the same household. The safety team will not provide cover unless they are satisfied the conditions permit safe sailing.

Note 4 – Individuals intending to sail, MUST be satisfied they are within their capabilities in the conditions prevailing and expected.

Note 5 – If conditions deteriorate or safety resources are overwhelmed, the sessions may be terminated early.

Note 6 – Sailors are requested to use any and all of the 4 water access points and to ensure there are no more than 6 people on the slipway at any one time, when launching and recovering their dinghy.

Note 7 – The changing rooms are not open. Members choosing to change on the Boat Park are reminded that the area is covered by CCTV, with high definition facilities! Areas under the balcony, in the garden and directly under the wall are not covered. If you can't see the camera, it cannot see you.
