Explanation

Government restrictions have relaxed from 4/7/20 to allow unlimited activity on water.

Note 1.1 All sailors are required to sail with caution and with every consideration to those who may have to come to your rescue. Do not sail beyond your personal limits or those of your boat. Do not take needless risks.

Note 1.2 Race teams continue to have minimal personnel so they can comply with social distancing requirements; safety boats will usually have single crew. As an additional safety precaution Club Racing must not take place in wind speeds greater that an average of 20kts (as measured by the anemometer sited on the Portland Harbour NE Breakwater)

Note 1.3 The Clubhouse and Changing rooms remain closed. Social distancing of 2m must be maintained on the Boat Park, this can only be reduced if other mitigations are in place (same household, social 'bubble', face coverings worn). Maintaining safe distancing will require patience and cooperation especially in potentially congested areas such as slipways or on the pier and pontoon.

2. The Temporary SI's dated 6th July are rescinded with the following notes:

Note 2.1 Trophies will still not be awarded but awards may be made.

Note 2.2 A limited range of marks are available for racing, currently limited to the Moveable Marks as described in the handbook SI's and WSC marks in Weymouth Bay. Further notice will be issued if and when any Fixed Marks become available in the harbour.
